## **DIFFERENCES PRIMARY-SECONDARY**



	Primary	Secondary
• When	o During classes	<ul> <li>During 'free periods in students schedule'</li> <li>Thus sometimes during lunchtime</li> <li>S1-S2</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Students leave classgroup to work with support teacher</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Students follow 100% schedule (as in sms) and are not taken out of the class for support</li> </ul>
		o 1 period a week, max 2 periods a week (unless assisted student)

## **DIFFERENCES PRIMARY-SECONDARY**

<ul> <li>Support for different subjects</li> <li>Somethimes 2 to 5 periods a week</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Holistic approach: Become independent and ready for the bac</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Students</li> <li>mature, grow up</li> <li>want to become more independant</li> <li>feel easier stigmatised</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Students need time to</li> <li>Relax</li> <li>Spend time with friends</li> </ul>

• For who?	<ul> <li>All students who can use it and are putting effort in their studies</li> </ul>
• Content	<ul> <li>Learning to learn in small groups</li> <li>Per year level</li> <li>Starts from the work of each individual student</li> </ul>

	Intensive A Support (IsA)	General support (MS and IsB)
• For who?	<ul> <li>Students with multidisciplinary report</li> <li>E.g. Dyslexia, dyscalculia, HP,</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>New students, students with failures, students in difficulty</li> </ul>
• Content	<ul> <li>Pedagogical support</li> <li>Methodology</li> <li>Technics to learn</li> <li>Organisational</li> <li>(Sometimes orientated to maths or L1)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Subject related support</li> <li>Mathematics (basic programm)</li> <li>L1, L2</li> <li>Normally NOT for L3 in S1-S3; options (math6, chem in S6,)</li> </ul>

• Organisation	∘ Individual support	<ul><li>Support in small groups</li><li>Exceptionally individual</li></ul>
• Who requests?	<ul> <li>Parents contact support team with assessment report</li> <li>&lt; 4 years old, 2 years for bac-cycle request</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>○ (Teacher → Parents →) subject teacher → ESCO-team</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Including tests, test results, conclusions and recommendations for the school</li> <li>Original (+ translation EN/FR/DE)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Does not start before (mid) october (teachers need to assess first)</li> </ul>

	Intensive A Support (IsA)	General support, MS and IsB
Key figures	<ul> <li>Support teacher and/or Assistant</li> </ul>	Support teacher with subject teacher
• Start	<ul> <li>Mid september</li> </ul>	o Mid october, early november (first results!)
<ul> <li>Information</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>15 days after start: all teachers are informed</li> </ul>	o Info about start and end
	<ul> <li>Dec and May/June: parents are informed about evolution, progression</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Info about evolution: subject teacher and support teacher</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>May/June: SAG-evaluation meeting with parents and (main)teachers</li> </ul>

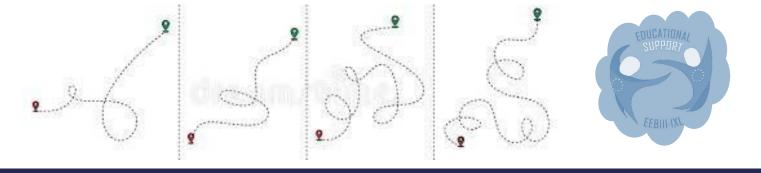

promotion - progression



#### **Students in promotion**

- Follows the full standard curriculum of ES
- 100% Assessed as other students (orals i.s.o written tests is not possible\*\*)
- Needs to be promoted by the class-council in Juin

#### Student in progression

- Follows an individual program (this might be a minor change or complete individual program)
- For several courses assessed differently
- Accompanies the classgroup to the next year level (no certification\*\*)
- Can go back into promotion after full assessment and promotion by the class-council





# Inclusive education – special arrangements



#### S1 - S5

- Report needed (max 4 years old)
- Not to compensate the lack of ability
- Allow to achief potentials in fair conditions
- Recommendations in the report are discussed in the SAG-meeting with parents and support-team > no guarantee they are all implemented
- → Only after approval of SAG
- → Decission of the school

#### Bac-cycle

- Request is done early S<sub>5</sub> (deadline: 15 octobre)
- Parents of students in IsA are informed at the end of S4
- Specific file must be filled in
- Full report is needed (max 2 years old)
- The arrangements approved will be put in place (no discussion)
- → Full assessment of max 2 years old needed
- → Decision of the Central office
